



Extension Application For Residents of Canyon County and Kuna

Extensions are available if a vehicle is out of the testing area and cannot easily be returned to the area, the vehicle's owner or operator is temporarily located outside the covered testing area (Canyon County and the City of Kuna) and cannot easily return, or a vehicle is nonoperational. A time extension of up to 6 months may be granted if the conditions specified below are met. This extension does not apply to operational vehicles in an area currently conducting emissions testing approved for reciprocity or that could reasonably be driven to an area that has such emissions testing (see Table 1 for jurisdictions with approved vehicle emissions testing programs). If the operational vehicle is in one of these areas, the owner or operator of that vehicle must have it tested in that area and submit the emissions test document to the program for compliance credit.

Before the extension expires, the vehicle must be emissions tested.

Only complete applications with all required supporting documentation will be considered for extensions. Applicants will need to call (208) 461-1232 to find out the status of their application.

Instructions for Submitting an Extension Application

1. Complete the entire "Extension Application."
2. Provide proof of the vehicle's status or owner's location. Documentation may support, but is not limited to, the following situations:
 - **Active duty military service** --The vehicle owner must **provide a copy of the service member's most recent military orders**. The extension is good for 2 years. If the vehicle or owner remains out of the area after 2 years, then a new extension will have to be certified.
 - **Full-time student registration** --The vehicle owner must **submit proof of full-time student status**. The extension will not exceed 1 year.
 - **Corporate assignment** --The vehicle owner must **provide proof of assignment, which might include a letter from the employer stating the reason and duration of the deployment**. The length of extension will be determined on a case-by-case basis not to exceed 1 year.
 - **Out-of-area motorist or vehicle outside of testing area.** -- An extension *may* be granted if the motorist is away from the testing area and the vehicle remains undriven. Upon returning to the testing area or the expiration of the extension, the vehicle must be tested and must pass or apply for a waiver. (For example, a resident of Canyon County or Kuna leaves a vehicle home and travels south for the winter or leaves a vehicle at a vacation home for the season.) An extension will not be granted or necessary if the vehicle is being driven in an area with a vehicle emissions testing program approved for reciprocity with Idaho (Table 1).

The vehicle owner must **provide a signed letter describing the location of the vehicle, a proof of location, such as a utility bill from that location, and the date when the vehicle will return.**
 - **Nonoperational vehicles** --A vehicle that is **not drivable** may qualify for an extension not to exceed 6 months from the testing due date. *The vehicle will not be eligible for any other extensions until the vehicle passes an emissions test.*

The owner of the vehicle must **provide a signed letter describing the vehicle's nonoperational state.**

Please be aware that local codes and ordinances may apply to the location or storage of nonoperational vehicles. For information, contact your city and/or county planning and zoning office.

- **Businesses with principal address in Canyon County or Kuna** --If a business has its principal physical address in Canyon County or within the city limits of Kuna but operating outside of the immediate testing area, these businesses may be eligible for an extension. The vehicle owner should verify that the vehicle is not required to be registered in the location in which it primarily operates. If the vehicle is in another area where testing is being conducted, the vehicle may be tested in accordance with the reciprocity waiver policy (Table 1).

The business must **submit a certified letter on company letterhead detailing the nature of the business, the location of the vehicle, and the date the vehicle is expected to be tested.**

- **Religious or humanitarian missions** --An extension is available to individuals who are serving on religious or humanitarian missions during the period of their required emissions test and are not assigned to an area currently performing emissions tests or do not have their vehicles with them. These motorists are eligible for an extension not to exceed 2 years.

The vehicle owner must **provide proof of assignment, which might include a letter from the church or organization stating the reason and duration of the mission.**

- Company vehicle located outside the testing area
- Religious or humanitarian mission
- I understand that no additional waivers or extensions will be granted for the above listed vehicle until the vehicle has been tested or the extension has been recertified as in the case for active-duty military service.
- I understand that an extension is good for the time specified from the original testing due date, and at the term of this extension the vehicle listed above must be tested or I must contact the program office for further assistance.
- I understand that failure to submit all requested documentation with a fully completed application will delay or deny this request.
- I understand that if an active vehicle emissions testing program exists where the vehicle is located, I must have it tested in that area and submit the emissions test document to the emission testing office.**

In accordance with the "Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho" (IDAPA 58.01.01.123), I certify, based on information and belief formed after reasonable inquiry, the statements and information in the document are true, accurate, and complete.
